





When eatables are carried in them, the chemicals used to make them get mixed with them. So polythene bags make the food items poisonous. If the animals chew them, they go to their abdomen and cause them severe pain and most of the time become a strong reason for their deaths.

He further added that polythene bags cause drainage problem and make the city ugly. The 80% of the total garbage is made of polythene bags.

The Chief Guest also enlightened the people about drawbacks of the use of poly-bags. Besides agreeing with the Principal about the hazardous caused by polythene bags, he preferred to tell their substitutes.

He said that instead of these plastic bags, people must use bags made of cloth, paper and jute. He admitted that law couldn't do much in that regard, the ban must come from within. Then the Chief Guest administered the oath to the people that they would not use poly-bags.

Report on Suicide Awareness

The event began with Mr. Mir Aizaj, Assistant Professor Civil Engg Department elaborating the meaning of social awareness. This day is also regarded as National Suicide Awareness Day. He pointed out that Suicide awareness is a proactive effort to raise awareness around suicidal behaviors. It is focused on reducing social stigmas and ambiguity, by bringing attention to suicide statistically and sociologically, and encouraging positive dialogue and engagement as a means to prevent suicide. He also stressed on the fact that Suicide awareness is not a medical engagement, but a combination of medical, social, emotional and even financial counselling. Suicide awareness in adolescents focuses on the age group between 10–24 years, beginning with the onset of puberty, according to combined definitions and theories found in developmental psychology. He presented a statistical analysis of suicide rates across the globe. He also cited several factors /causes of suicide. The chief among them are-

1. Depression
2. Bipolar disorder
3. Problems with alcohol or drugs
4. Loss (relational, social, work, or financial)
5. Social isolation
6. Unusual thoughts and behaviour, or confusion about reality

Mr. Zishan Aslam, Assistant Professor Civil Engg. Department suggested preventive factors or conditions that may have a positive effect on youth and reduce the possibility of suicide attempts.

Students developed posters to celebrate the World Water Day 2015 based on their creative messages and thinking on global water issues.

The event began with Mr. Vaseem Shahnaz, Head of CE department addressing the students about the importance of safe drinking water. He pointed out that presently, water, sanitation, and hygiene are global concerns and priority areas in the international development sector. Although the Millennium Development Goals included improved drinking water supply, water quality and safety are still very precarious in many regions of the world. He also stated the fact that billions of people still rely on unsafe drinking water sources such as rivers, streams, ponds, unprotected open wells, and poorly protected springs— their households, schools, workplaces, farms and factories struggling to survive and thrive. In addition, some populations who are using "improved" drinking water sources are still not consuming safe water.

Mr. Zeeshan Aslam, Assistant Professor, CE Department presented a statistical analysis that poor sanitation accounts for the death of a child every 20 seconds, including 88% of deaths caused by diarrheal disease and people's insufficient access to sanitation. The United Nations estimates that good hygiene and a safe water supply could save 1.5 million children's lives a year.

The concluding session was witnessed by Prof. Mohammed Asghar Principal CoET, BGSBU. Speaking on the occasion he expressed his satisfaction with the event and stressed on the importance of such events regarding water conservation for a healthy living and for our future generations.


This is to certify that following event/s were organized by Department of Botany during the academic year 2016-2017:
