the first meeting of Board of Governors (BoG) of the College of Engineering & Technology (under TEQIP-III Programme) held on January 19, 2018 at 11:00 am in the Conference Room of General Zorawar Singh Auditorium, University of Jammu, Jammu.

The proceedings of the BoG commenced with the recitation of verses from the Holy Quran. The Vice Chancellor, Prof. Javed Mussarat called the meeting to order. The Vice-Chancellor extended warm welcome to all the members of the BoG, particularly those who had come from long distance despite their busy schedule. The Vice-Chancellor hoped that the College of Engineering and Technology of BGSB University will be immensely benefitted with the association and active participation of all the BoG members which will definitely enhance the academic profile of the College.

Thereafter, the agenda items were taken up for consideration.

Item No.1: To report the brief facts about SoET, BGSBU and TEQIP-III Project

The Vice Chancellor apprised the members of the BoG briefly about the College of Engineering & Technology (CoET) of BGSBU now known as School of Engineering & Technology (SoET). This College was established in 2007 as a constituent College of BGSBU to serve as the premier learning Centre in the field of Engineering and Technology. A total of five main branches i.e., (i) Civil Engineering (CE), (ii) Computer Science & Engineering (CSE), (iii) Electrical & Renewable Energy Engineering (ERE), (iv) Electronics & Communications

Engineering (ECE) and (v) Information Technology & Engineering (ITE) each with the intake of 60 seats were established.

The Vice Chancellor further informed that the TEQIP-III programme is the third phase of TEQIP Scheme which started as TEQIP -I primarily with the World Bank funding in collaboration with Ministry of Human Resource Development, New Delhi with the total budgetary provision of nearly 3006 crores. The Institutions of Jammu & Kashmir viz. Government College of Engineering and Technology (GCET), Jammu, Shri Mata Vaishno Devi University (SMVDU), Katra, Islamic University of Science and Technology (IUST), Awantipora and Baba Ghulam Shah Badshah University (BGSBU), Rajouri were sanctioned a grant of Rs. 15 crores each for three years starting from April 2017 to March 2020. The activities of the TEQIP funded institutions are being monitored centrally by National Project Implementation Unit (NPIU) and regionally by State Project Implementation Unit (SPIU). TEQIP-III is different from TEQIP I & II in as much as the guidelines in TEQUIP-III are more stringent and all transactions are on-line through PFMS and PMSS portals as a new digital initiative. The BGSB University was considered under 1.1 category as mentee Institute and Zakir Hussain College of Engineering & Technology, Aligarh Muslim University (AMU), Aligarh was chosen as mentor institution (1.3) under the mandatory twinning programme between the two institutions to take assistance of mentor Institute through mutual exchange of TEQIP personnel of the two institutions.

The members lauded the efforts of the Vice-Chancellor and his team to get this substantial grant and hoped that it will give a new fillip and impetus to the on-going programmes of CoET and will comprehensively augment its infrastructural facilities.

Item No.2: To report the submission of Institutional Development Plan (IDP) of TEQIP-III Project for the consideration of MHRD, New Delhi

The Vice Chancellor informed the BoG that a detailed institutional Development Plan (IDP) was submitted to Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) on 3-3-2017 for its consideration under TEQIP — III progamme and the final sanction of the same was communicated to Commissioner Secretary (Higher Education) vide letter No. AC/TEQIP-III/MHRD/2017, dated: June 26, 2017 from Dr. P.M. Khodke, Central Project Advisor for duration of three years commencing from April 1, 2017. Two MoUs — one between the State Government and BGSB University and the other between the twining institutions i.e. BGSB University as



mentee institution (1.1) and Zakir Hussain College of Engineering & Technology, Aligarh Muslim University (AMU), Aligarh as mentor institution (1.3) were singed.

The members noted and approved the above details.

Item No.3: To report and adopt the Draft Project Implementation Plan (PIP) of MHRD, New Delhi

The BoG perused the Project Implementation Plan (PIP)(June 2017) provided by the Department of Higher Eduction. Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) and unanimously adopted and approved the same.

Item No.4: To report and adopt Mandatory incorporation of AICTE 10-pointprogram in the Action Plan of participating Institutes

The BoG adopted AICTE mandatory 10-point program in the action plan of the participating institutes for quarters starting from October-December, 2017. Further, the members emphasized the implementation of the above mandatory requirement in letter and spirit.

The BoG adopted Financial Management Manual (March 201) of TEQIP-III Project provided by MHRD, New Delhi and suggested strict compliance of manual.

He also highlighted the need to establish Innovation Club to nurture the talent of the students and a dedicated Cell consisting of a Consortium of Corporates, Captains of Industry and academia to serve as an interaction platform which will immensely benefit the institution.

All the above suggestions were appreciated by the members of BoG and the Vice –Chancellor assured to consider them in all earnestness.

Item No.15: To report the conduction of Induction Programme for B.Tech. 1st Year Students

Item No.23: To approve the Student travel for internship and reimbursement of GATE Fees under TEQIP-III Project

The Student travel for internship and reimbursement of GATE Fees under TEQIP-III Project as mandated by NPIU was approved.

Prof. Ashok Aima suggested that project-based learning should be incorporated and encouraged.

Item No.24: To approve the Guidelines for TA/DA for faculty/Staff for TEQIP-III activities and Honorarium to Experts for delivering Lecture and Attending meetings

In view of the prevalence of two set of guidelines in vogue in the University, it has been approved that Chairman BoG/Coordinator TEQIP-III is authorized to use need-based discretion to approve TA/DA judiciously to ensure larger participation and optimum utilization of grant.

Prof. Ashok Aima & Prof. Abdul Khaliq suggested that 'Best Teacher' and 'Best Researcher Award' may be instituted under TEUIP-III programme at College level for promoting competition among faculty members.

Prof. Iqbal Parwez, TEQIP-III Coordinator informed the hon'ble members that the University has already instituted "Outstanding Researcher of the Year Award" carrying a research grant of 2 lacs separately, for Humanities and Science

Prof. ISBAL PARWEZ Coordinator TEQIP-III BGSB University Rajouri (J&K) streams in addition to 'Best Innovator Award (Teacher)', 'Best Innovator Award (Student)' also 'Best Sport Person (Boy)' and 'Best Sport Person (Girl)' Award which was distributed on the Foundation Day Function every year on December 15. He assured the members that the feasibly of the proposed award under TEQIP – III programme will be explored.

Item No. 25: Implementation of directives of NPIU/SPIU/MHRD/World Bank regarding TEQIP-III grants as and when received

The Chairman, BoG has been authorized for adoption and implementation of all future directives of NPIU/SPIU/MHRD/World Bank regarding TEQIP-III grants as and when received.
