The Department of Biotechnology organized webinar on topic “**Ethics Soul of Research**”. The ethics of scientific research is somewhat unique within professional ethics in the sense that good science requires the ethical practice of science. Research ethics is approached through a single course or a series of courses or seminars throughout the graduate curriculum; it has become obvious that students need exposure to ethics in a number of contexts. Webinar started with the lecture of Dean School of biosciences and biotechnology who laid emphases on Research ethics by saying that ethics can and must be taught in a formalized manner. It is our belief that courses in research ethics that incorporate a solid philosophical framework have the greatest potential for long-term usefulness to students. While other methodologies may reinforce this material, a course of the type described in this monograph has the potential to help a student develop the tools to see ethical problems from a new vantage point. It is in this context and for these reasons that we designed our course in research ethics. A total of 60 participants got registered in the webinar while as the faculty members of the department, scholars and students were also present during the virtual session.

World Water Day celebrated at Environmental Sciences, CBS, BGSB University

Environmental Sciences, Centre for Biodiversity Studies, BGSB University, Rajouri celebrated World Water Day. The theme of World Water Day 2022 is "Groundwater, making the invisible visible". Prof Akbar Masood, Vice Chancellor, BGSBU in his message emphasized that the World Water Day, is held on March 22nd every year since 1993 for conserving water and water resources. Prof Akbar further stressed that the main focus of World Water Day is to enable the achievement of Sustainable Development Goal 6 which is water and sanitation for all by 2030 and since groundwater is the largest source of fresh and usable water in the world, therefore, it must be managed and valued.

A special lecture by Professor Lalit M. Tewari, Department of Botany, Kumaon University, Nainital, Uttarakhand was organized to celebrate the event in which the staff, scholars and students of Environmental Sciences, CBS participated.

Dr. A. A. Shah, Associate Dean, School of Biosciences and Biotechnology while giving opening remarks said that the exploring, protecting and sustainably using groundwater will be central to surviving and adapting to climate change and meeting the needs of a growing population.



She highlighted that economically important wild plants are an integral part of the traditional health care systems of the rural as well as urban communities. In the current COVID-19 pandemic scenario, Ministry of Aayush, Govt. of India has also recommended regular consumption of concoctions of various herbs as immunity booster.
