

Report on Road Safety Camp

School of Education, Baba Ghulam Shah Badshah Rajouri, in collaboration of ARTO Rajouri Shri Neeraj Sharma organized a awareness camp on "Road Safety" for the youth of Rajouri in the Camps of BGSB University on 05 Feb. 2018. Prof. G.M. Malik, Dean and Head, School of Education presented a warm welcome to the ARTO of Rajouri. He also discussed the need and importance of this awareness camp. Many students and faculty members of the University also joined the camp.

Shri Neeraj Sharma, ARTO Rajouri, initiated with providing some knowledge about traffic rules and other important aspects. He said,"Road traffic injuries are a major but neglected public health challenge that requires concerted efforts for effective and sustainable prevention. Of all the systems with which people have to deal every day, road traffic systems are the most complex and the most dangerous. Worldwide, an estimated 1.2 million people are killed in road crashes each year and as many as 50 million are injured. Projections indicate that these figures will increase by about 65% over the next 20 years unless there is new commitment to prevention.

Some students of the University also spoke about the road safety and requested the public to "Drive slow and Drive safe." In the end, Shri Neeraj Sharma with the help of faculty members distributed some helmet to the students and guided them to wear the helmet while driving.
