**NOTIFICATION**

**Sub:- Submission of Online Scholarship applications under Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities Sponsored Scheme "Post Matric Scholarship For Students With Disabilities" for the year 2025-26.**

Online applications are invited from the students, eligible for above mentioned Scheme ("Post Matric Scholarship For Students With Disabilities" pursuing their PG, UG, and Diploma Courses in the University. The scheme has been launched by the Department of Disability Affairs during the Financial Year 2014-15. The objective of the scheme is to provide financial assistance to the parents of students with disabilities for studying in the post matric level. The parental income ceiling per annum is Rs 2.5 lakhs. The objective of the Scheme is to provide financial assistance to the differently - abled students to enable them to pursue degree and/or post graduate level technical and professional courses from a recognized institution.

A person with disability having not less than 40% disability and having a disability certificate issued by the competent Medical Authority. Not more than two disabled children of the same parents will be entitled to receive benefits of the scheme. In case if the second child is a twin, the scholarship under these schemes will be admissible to both twins. Scholarship for studying in any class will be available for only one year. If a student has to repeat a class, he/she would not get scholarship for a second (or subsequent) year. A scholarship holder under these schemes will not hold any other scholarship/stipend. If awarded any other scholarship/stipend, the student can exercise his/her option for either of the two scholarships/stipends, which is more beneficial to him/her and should inform the awarding authority through the Head of the Institution about the option exercised.

Before initiating registration process, students are advised to carefully go through "Guidelines for Registration on National Scholarship Portal" and keep their educational and other documents, such as, Aadhaar Number, Enrolment No., Bank Pass Book etc. in hand. The Student applying for scholarship first time need to "Register" on the portal as fresh applicant by using the icon "New Registration" through website [www.scholarships.gov.in](http://www.scholarships.gov.in) by providing accurate and correct information as per their documents. Only Online applications under these Schemes will be accepted and no request for offline applications will be entertained. The details / eligibility of the Scheme are as mentioned below:

**ELIGIBILITY FOR SCHOLARSHIP:**

1. One passport size photograph.
2. Online application form duly authenticated from concerned Deans / Directors / Principals / Heads of the Department.
3. Fee receipt in original without cutting /mutation in name of the candidate, Date, Class/Course/semester duly signed and stamped by Competent Authority.

4. Bonafide Certificate in original issued by concerned Deans/Principals/Heads of the Department in which annual fee is mentioned.
5. Disability Certificate. A person with disability having not less than 40% disability and having a disability certificate issued by the competent medical authority.
6. The parental/guardian income from all sources should not exceed Rs.2.50 lakh per annum.
7. Previous Qualification mark sheets i.e. 10<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup>, Graduation, etc.
8. Domicile Certificate/Permanent Residence Certificate.
9. Valid Category Certificate (if any) issued by the competent (Revenue) Authority
10. Photo copy of the Bank Pass-Book indicating complete particulars i.e., Name of the Account Holder, Address, **Active Bank Account Number**, Bank Branch & IFSC Code etc.
11. Aadhar number along with photo copy of the Aadhar Card which has been linked with 16 digit bank account number which shall lead to smooth transaction of sanctioned amount of Scholarship in favour of eligible students.
12. Affidavit duly attested by the notary to be uploaded. The specimen of the affidavit is as under:


