Glowing Tribute were paid to Molana Azad for contribution to the educational system of the country on modern line.

Speaking on the occasion HOD Arabic , Dr. Shamas Kamal Anjum highlighted the fact that Maulana Abul Kalam Azad firmly believed in universal primary education, girls' education free and compulsory education for all children up to the age of 14, vocational training and technical education. Dr. Shamas Said that Maulana fought for country's freedom and in 1912, he started a weekly journal in Urdu called Al-Hilal to increase the revolutionary recruits. For his contribution — both as an educationist as a freedom fighter — he was awarded the Bharat Ratna in 1992. He strongly advocated the education of women. In 1949, in the Central Assembly, he emphasized the importance of imparting instruction in modern sciences and knowledge. He also said that no programme of national education can be appropriate if it does not give full consideration to the education and advancement of one-half of the society — that is the women.


