Kindly find the document related with above cited subject. Following are the reports which are compiled by taking feedback from various stakeholders.

1. Feedback report from Students:

The feedback of the students during the academic years 2013-2014, 2014-15, and 2015-2016, were collected every semester. About 80% of the students had participated in the exit survey.

1. The students insisted that more time should be given to them for doing practicals.

2. The students reported that new topics related with electrical engineering should be taught to them

3. The students insisted to assign mentors to them

4. Student's presentation and communication skills have to be improved further to make them employable through some mandatory courses.

5. The syllabus of Engineering Chemistry & Environmental Science (ERE-126) needs change.

2. Feedback report from Alumni:

Feedbacks were taken from pass out batches 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012, during the academic years 2013-2014, 2014-2015, and 2015-2016, respectively. About 60% of them had responded to the survey. Their feedback was summarized and is as follows:

1. Courses like Microcontrollers, Restructuring of Power Systems, Substation designs, Extra high voltage should be taught so as to enable the students to write competitive exams like GATE, IES and Written tests conducted by various companies.

2. Courses like Power Quality, Smart Grid technologies and PIC Microcontrollers could be included, so as to enable the students to succeed in the interviews for jobs in core companies.

3. Courses on Renewable energy sources should be taught with more practical exercises, so as to enable the students to do well in competitive exams and also urge students to start start-ups etc.

4. A laboratory course related to Electrical drives should be introduced which would give a deep insight on the drives that would help students in industry.

3. Feedback report from Faculty members:

Feedback report was taken from all the Faculty members who taught the courses of the program. Their suggestions were consolidated as detailed below:

1. Topics like Electrical Machines and Renewable Energy Sources shall be taught with more inclination towards practical exposure.

2. The faculty suggested that workshops, symposium, seminars should be organised by the department.

3. The concepts of the Artificial Neural Networks and Disaster Management shall be made mandatory as these were in vogue.

4. Feedback report from Employers:

Feedbacks were taken from 2009, 2010, and 2011 pass out batch Employers. They suggested that course curriculum should be structured in such a way to increase the technical skill and programming skills in them so that they could easily transfer theoretical knowledge in to practical works. Moreover new courses such as Microcontrollers, Extra high Voltage (EHV) should encouraged among students to take them as electives.

5. Feedback report from Parents:

Feedbacks were also distributed among the parents for their valuable suggestions. They suggested that course curriculum should be structured in such a way to increase the opportunities for the students to clear various exams and syllabus should be inclined towards changing industrial needs.

- Most of the students have expressed their satisfaction with the faculty, the infrastructure, ambience and good admission process, however there is some scope of improvement as well.


Action Taken:

Responses recorded in the questionnaire are coded as 1,2,3,4,5, as 1 for Poor, 2 for average, 3 for good , 4 for Very good and 5 for Excellent, Column wise codes represent as Column I:-Load Of Courses, Column II:Availability of Text Books, Column III: Quality relevance. Column IV: Treatment. Column V: Ambience. Column VI: Relevance of Courses. Column VII: Comfort of workload. Column VIII: Quality of teaching. Column IX: Achievements . Column X:Job Placements. About 60% of respondents responses were very Good and 40% consider it excellent while only 20% responses were poor. About availability of Books and references available in the department, 30% of the parents say Poor, 20% of the parents responded very Good and 50% of respondents replied Excellent.

Regarding the quality and relevance of the courses in curriculum, responses were also satisfactory. 60% of the parents responded Good and 30% chose excellent as response. It is evident from the table that the treatment of the students by the faculty is irrespective of the background of the students (Gender, Caste, Sex, Community and Creed etc). More than 60-70 % of parents have responded the treatment excellently. Regarding effective delivery of the academic process 50% of the parents have shown their interest and responded Good. However only 40% of the parents have responded with the option of 'excellent', largely because of the unawareness of the questions posed. The responses about workload is also satisfactory as it ranges

The data also reveals if the parameters combined together the University is at the stage of prosperity despite the geographical disadvantage.


FACULTY FEEDBACK:

Report of analysis of feedback received from different stakeholder's semester wise/ year wise

Curriculum refers to the knowledge and practices in subject matter areas that teachers teach and that students are supposed to learn. A curriculum generally consists of a scope, or breadth of content, in a given subject area and of a sequence of concepts and activities for learning. Before holding the Board of Studies, the curriculum and the scheme of the programme is thoroughly deliberated in the Departmental Affairs Committee (DAC) where suggestions and the feedback is being critically analyzed. The feedback from the alumni members, faculty, students, recruiters and industry experts were taken and the short-comings are identified so that the curriculum shall bridge the gap between academia and industry. The evaluation of the students is being assessed taking into account the Mid Term Examination and the corresponding Term End Papers of previous curriculum and the level of discrepancy in the course if any. The job of DAC is to discuss the issues related to all the things pertaining to Academics.

After the feedback is collected from the various stakeholders, meetings within the Department are being conveyed to address the concerns of the stakeholders. The feedback was collected based on the following criteria:

- 1. Coverage of fundamental concepts.
- 2. Fulfillment of the course objectives.
- 3. The course workload was manageable.
- 4. The course is relevant to practical/lab work.
- 5. Provision of learning resources in the library was appropriate and adequate.
- 6. The teacher was responsive to student needs and problems.
- 7. Relevance of Curriculum as per industry requirements.
- 8. Whether any change in curriculum is required or Not?

From the feedback obtained for the academic years 2013-14, 2014-15 and 2015-16, it was observed that there is a need to enhance the practical applicability of the syllabus. It was also observed that recent technologies which were not yet covered in the Syllabi need to be incorporated in the Syllabus.

Following actions were taken by the Department.

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- 1. In each semester only four theory papers and two lab courses were introduced.
- 2. Credits to Lab were enhanced from 2 Credits to 4 Credits.
- 3. Choice Based Open Elective Courses was introduced.
- 4. Choice Based Complimentary Elective courses were introduced.
- 5. New Courses(Subjects) were introduced like Cloud Computing, Bio Informatics& Web Mining.
- 6. Minor Project was introduced for the 4th Semester Students so that the students shall get a feel of developing and designing a software application.

From the feedback obtained for the academic years 2016-17 and 2017-18, it was felt that the changes made in the current syllabus has addressed the short comingsof the previous syllabus like practical applications. It was also observed that recent technologies like Big Data, IOT and Machine Learning need to be incorporated in the Syllabus.
