**Dear Sir/Madam,**

I am pleased to inform you that after due process of expert evaluation of your application and on the recommendations of the MHRD-Empowered Committee, University Grants Commission has selected you as the UGC-Dr. D.S. Kothari Post Doctoral Fellow. The postdoctoral fellowship (PDF) is tenable for a period of upto 3 years for research in the chosen area as accepted by your Mentor Prof.

1. While the maximum duration of the PDF award is 3 years, the fellowship is awarded on a yearly basis with renewal/termination clause on the basis of PDF mentor/expert appraisal. You have to give an undertaking while joining the PDF award, duly endorsed by the research mentor, that you would undertake the PDF project, as per your proposal, in the approved workplace through the Registrar of the University.
  2. You would be paid a monthly fellowship of Rs.22,000 (Bridging Fellowship), Rs.28,000 (Regular Fellowship with an annual increment of Rs. 1000/- and Rs.30,000(Higher Fellowship). In case, subsidised accommodation is not provided by the university, applicable HRA as per rules would be paid. However, in case of candidates, who have not yet been awarded Ph.D degree, a "Bridging Fellowship" of Rs.22, 000/- plus applicable HRA would be paid till the Ph.D. degree is awarded. HRA claim, if admissible, may be submitted through the Registrar of the University indicating the admissible percentage of HRA prevailing in the University.
  3. The PDF award will carry a contingency grant of Rs.1,00,000/- p.a.
  4. The awardee shall submit electronically annual progress report of the research work through the respective mentor with a certificate of satisfactory performance from the date of commencement of the Project to UGC National Co-ordinator (Dr. D.S. Kothari Postdoctoral Fellowship Scheme) at [dskpdf@unipune.ernet.in](mailto:dskpdf@unipune.ernet.in) with a subject title Annual Progress Report. In case, the research work is found unsatisfactory, the award is liable to be discontinued.
- The UGC will release first year grant for PDF in advance. The awardee shall also submit utilization certificate indicating utilization of fellowship duly endorsed by the Registrar/Finance Officer of university/Principal of college after end of the year of fellowship award to enable UGC to release next installment of grant.
5. The awardee shall invariably mention in all research publication that the research has been sponsored by the UGC under the UGC Dr. D.S. Kothari Post Doctoral Fellowship Scheme.
  6. The awardee shall have to join the department and the mentor as early as possible but not later than a period of 6 months from the date of issue of this award letter. The date from which the awardee has joined this award may be communicated to the Commission.
  7. The terms and conditions under this award as may be amended from time to time by the Commission shall be abided by the awardee.
  8. You are also requested to fill up the enclosed format and send a hard and soft copy to the undersigned.

As part of U.S. security procedures, applications for visas are being sent to the State Department where they are reviewed. The website for the State Department is <http://www.state.gov>. We advise scientists traveling to the United States to apply for a visa as early as possible (at least three months before a visa is needed). Because of the number of visas being processed, and the need to be thorough with the reviews, this review can take as long as 12 weeks, especially for those countries on the State Sponsors of Terrorism List.

The State Department announced that, beginning in August 2008, visitors traveling to the U.S. from visa waiver countries (i.e. Europe, Japan, Australia, etc.) will have to register online 3 days in advance of travel. This rule is now mandatory as of January 12, 2009.
